

Draft LR re tracking greyhounds – properties, location and activities

<p>When and where a greyhound is born (or soon after)</p> <p>See existing applicable rules – GAR 136 (result of service), GAR 137 (registration of litter) (also service regulations, GAR 126 – 129A)</p>	
<p>Location for keeping greyhounds – Greyhound Training Properties</p> <p>See also existing applicable rules – LR 11A and 11.9. 11.10 and 11.11, (Greyhound Training Properties), LR 16.3 (registered person to notify Board of change of address, trainer to notify of change in residence or location of kennels), GAR 105 (notification of control and location of greyhound), see also GAR 106</p>	
LR, definitions	<p>“Greyhound Training Property” means the property or premises at which a person keeps <u>a greyhound or greyhounds for breeding, whelping, rearing, educating and/or training. a greyhound or greyhounds for breeding, whelping, rearing, educating and/or training. (unless retired as a pet), trains or races greyhounds and f</u>or the avoidance of doubt, <u>this, this</u> includes rearing farms, boarding and breaking in <u>or educating or educating</u> facilities.</p>
LR 11A 1	<p>The Board may prescribe categories of registration relative to a Greyhound Training Property.</p>
LR 11A 2A	<p>No person shall be granted registration of a Greyhound Training Property unless the person is in control of the property.</p>
LR 11A 5	<p>Unless sooner cancelled or suspended by the Board, the registration of a Greyhound Training Property remains in force for such time as may be prescribed by the Board. a period specified by the Board which cannot be longer than three (3) years.</p>

<p>LR 16.3 (existing rule with marked-up proposed amendments)</p>	<p>A Registered Person shall notify the Board in writing of any change <u>to his or her residential</u> of address within three (3) <u>working</u> days of such change. Without limitation, a Trainer shall so notify the Board immediately upon changing his or her place of residence or the location of his or her Kennels and the Board may at any time if it sees fit review his or her registration.</p>
<p>LR ##</p>	<p>(1) A greyhound must be kept at a Greyhound Training Property registered with the Board.</p>
<p>Notification when a greyhound moves location</p>	
<p>LR ##</p>	<p>(1) When a greyhound moves to or from being kept at a Greyhound Training Property registered with the Board, within ten (10) working days of the move the registered person in control of the greyhound and the Owner of the greyhound must notify the Board in the prescribed form.</p>
<p>Notification when a greyhound changes 'activities'</p>	
<p>LR ##</p>	<p>(1) When a greyhound changes activities, the registered person in control of the greyhound and the Owner of the greyhound must notify the Board in the prescribed form, within ten (10) working days of the change in activity.</p> <p>(2) For the purposes of subrule (1), 'activities' are breeding, whelping, rearing, educating and training.</p>

Notification when there is a change to the registered person in control of the greyhound

LR ##

- (1) A registered person must notify the Board in the prescribed form within ten (10) working days of when:
 - (a) a greyhound comes into his or her control
 - (b) a greyhound leaves his or her control.
- (2) An Owner of a greyhound must also notify the Board in the prescribed form when there is a change to the registered person in control of the greyhound, within ten (10) working days of the change.

When a greyhound ‘retires’
