Identify the Person in Charge

- identifying and writing the Protocols that apply to their Establishment
- the management of the Establishment, which includes the greyhounds in their care and,
- keeping records

Start thinking about your protocols

You can use the information in the Support Book to help draft your Protocols in preparation for the release of the Establishment and Health Management Plan Declaration Portal in July 2019.

Remember that, when finalised, your Protocols will need to be signed by a veterinarian.

2. Document your Protocols
3. Get a Vet to approve your EHMP (and enter into a Vet Agreement) and,
4. Complete and submit the EHMP Declaration Form
