

## **Using GRV's template Greyhound Record**

For those participants more comfortable with paper-based record-keeping, GRV have developed a template Greyhound Record similar to the Greyhound Record on FastTrack. Preprinted template Greyhound Record booklets are available from Clubs or can be downloaded and printed from the Code of Practice webpage.

Included in the Greyhound Record Booklet is a Guide that lists the same Injury, Illness and Health Management options available in FastTrack. Where possible, use the Guide as a look up table when entering information, as this will ensure consistency in the Greyhound Record if both the template and FastTrack are used for the same greyhound.

## **GREYHOUND RECORD: GUIDE**

When entering an Illness, Injury or Health Management Event, please select from the lists below for each matching section. This hardcopy Greyhound Record has been designed to match the Greyhound Record event options on FastTrack.



Separate pages for recording Injury, Illness or Health Management Events are included in the template.

## **Hints when Recording an Event**

- All fields must be completed, except for Comment/Observations.
- An Event is any activity such as an injury, illness or health management task that has occurred. For example, a task may be the type of treatment provided or a change to the usual routine.
- One injury may require different types of treatments plus a change to the usual routine. If so, each treatment and change is recorded as separate Events.
- One treatment may occur over multiple days. If so, only one Event entry is required.
- Under Vaccination type, "2i" refers to a type of "Kennel Cough" vaccine commonly given.

Remember to take a copy of the Greyhound Record to keep with your Establishment records before the greyhound leaves your Establishment. The Greyhound Record belongs to the greyhound and must accompany the greyhound wherever it goes.
