

Making a snuffle ball

What will you need?

- 4 square metres of fleece material
- 4 zip tie
- Scissors
- Tasty hard treats that are small enough to fit easily in Kong such as liver treats

Circles of 20cm will give you a ball of 20cm diameter

How do you make it?

Step 1

Cut 32 circles of about 20cm and make 4 holes in each circle (dots on the first picture)

Step 2

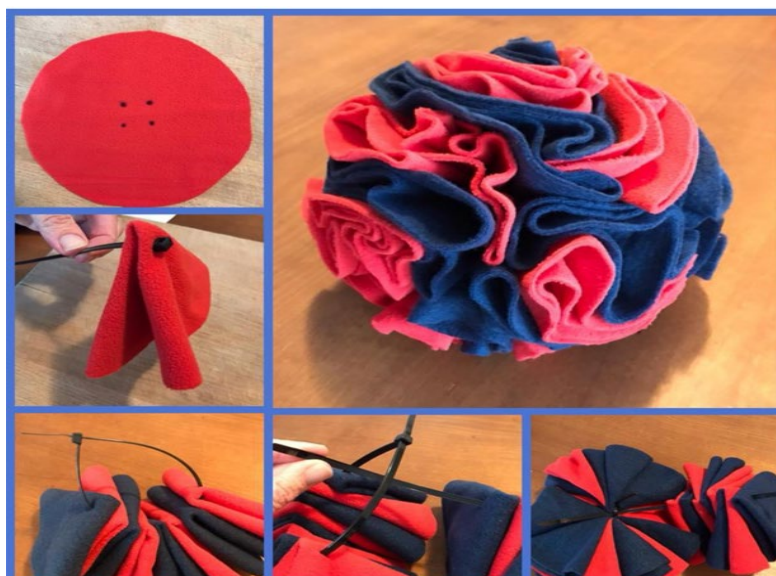
Fold the circles 2x and put 8 circles on each zip tie

Step 3

Close one zip tie (not too tight) and attach the other 3 zip ties from different sides on the first

Step 4

Close them all very tight and cut the ends of the zip ties off as far as possible, making sure the end is not too sharp.



Step 5

Break up the treats so they are small enough to hide amongst the material, near the base and leave it with the greyhound for a minimum of 1 hour.

Step 6

Throw a handful of treats on the ground away from the snuffle ball so you can safely and easily remove the snuffle mat from the dog's pen or kennel.

Step 7

Only use the ball once (per dog) before cleaning it. To clean it,

turn the ball upside down and give it a shake so that any the leftover food falls out. Rinse and place in the washing machine with detergent.
