Scanning at Club Trials

Purpose

To mandate the scanning of greyhounds prior to participating in any Club trial through a 'No Scan – No Trial' approach and outline the obligations on participants and Clubs in relation to the scanning of greyhounds at tracks managed by Clubs.

Scope

All Registered Persons, GRV staff and officials, and Club staff and officials must comply with the requirements in this policy.

Policy Principles

The scanning of greyhounds is an essential part of tracking the life of a greyhound and is essential to ensuring the welfare of greyhounds and the integrity of greyhound racing.

Information captured at trials will only be used as part of the Digital Greyhound Lifecycle Tracking Program (DGLTP)

A greyhound must be scanned, with the scanning technology provided by the Club, prior to a Club trial.

If a microchip cannot be located, the greyhound may complete the trial and Club staff must notify GRIW who will follow up with the participant.

Scanning at Club Trials – Registered Persons

The registered person in control of a greyhound must:

- allow the scan of the greyhounds brought to a racing club for the purposes of undertaking a trial, prior the greyhound undertaking the trial.
- not refuse to have their greyhounds scanned by club staff, GRV or any person authorised by GRV when attending a club trial.
- allow the use of the scanning technology provided by the Club to scan the greyhound.

It is an offence to fail to comply with this policy under GAR156(w).



Scanning at Club Trials – Clubs

Club staff responsible for collecting scanning information must ensure that all registered persons participating in a Club trial have scanned their greyhound prior to the trial.

Club staff collecting scanning data must ensure that it is submitted to GRV in the designated manner and process on a minimum weekly basis in order to be validated and uploaded to the DGLTP.

Clubs must ensure that scanning equipment is in good working order and available for use when a club trial is undertaken and at the published, designated times specified by the Club.
